RESTORATION WORKS AT S. SILAS I have now received an estimate for some long overdue items of restoration at S. Silas from the firm of specialists who have done the splendid work in S. John's Chapel at Walsingham. The High Altar Missal Stand which needs some repair and regilding will cost £550; in S. Thomas' Chapel, the Tabernacle Door will cost £845 and the canopy above the Altar £1,950. These prices do not include VAT, which will also be payable. If anyone is able to give us a donation, however small, towards the work, it would be very gratefully received. It would also be good to replace the carpet at S. Joseph's Altar which is almost entirely consumed by moths!
